



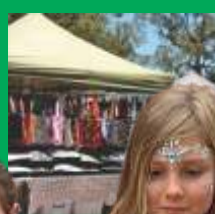

RULES & REGULATIONS (Revised 2017)

ENTRIES

1. Whether posted or hand delivered, it is the responsibility of Exhibitors to ensure Entry Forms are received by the Show Recorder no later than the closing date stated for each Section.
2. Entries should be on the official Entry Form (or photo copy) and lodged with Entry Fees.
3. Acceptance of late entries is at the Chief Steward's discretion and may incur a monetary penalty.
4. The Committee reserves the right to refuse, cancel or accept conditionally, any entry, without public explanation.
5. Unless elsewhere noted, exhibitors may enter as many distinct exhibits in each class as desired.
6. Entries in Sections A - H may be entered in the name of an individual, partnership or stud.
Exhibitors of stock are reminded they must have a waybill to transport stock to/from the Showgrounds (PIC No: **WFSG 0023**). **Please present to Chief Animal Steward.**

7. Entries in Sections J-T may only be in the name of a single individual. The Committee reserves the right, under particular circumstances, to accept collective entries.
8. Entry Fees and Prize Money are detailed within each Section of this Schedule.

EXHIBITS

9. Exhibits must be in the hands of the Stewards by the time stated in Section Notes and conform to the guidelines given in Section Notes. Exhibits not presented by that time may not be accepted for judging.
10. Anticipated judging times are stated in Section Notes but may vary slightly at the Steward's discretion.
11. Exhibits, Prize Cards and Ribbons must not be removed before 5.00pm on Show Day.
12. Points shall be awarded in Classes only (1st: 3pts, 2nd: 2pts, 3rd: 1pt). Exhibits will be judged on their merits and prizes awarded at the judge's discretion. For encouragement, children's category awards will be determined by comparison of exhibits on display.
13. Exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor and except for livestock and certain children's classes, either grown or made by the exhibitor.
14. No identification marks to be visible on exhibits unless requested in Section Notes.
15. Any entries deemed ineligible will be withdrawn from competition and the Entry Fee forfeited.

EXHIBITORS

15. Each exhibitor will receive a yellow "Confirmation of Entries" form when exhibits are presented to Stewards for staging. This lists all exhibits by the exhibitor and is a receipt for fees paid. ***This form must be presented to collect Prize Money and to collect exhibits at close of Show.***
16. Any exhibitor interfering with exhibits before or after judging may be disqualified.
17. All reasonable care will be taken to safeguard exhibits, but the Society does not accept responsibility for any loss of, or damage to, exhibits. It is a condition of entry

that each exhibitor shall hold the Society blameless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any such loss or damage. Exhibitors should claim their exhibits at close of Show as the Society is unable to ensure continued safe storage.

18. Exhibitors should ensure their exhibits are entered in the correct Class. The Chief Steward or a judge may alter the Class an exhibit is entered into, if the original Class entered is deemed inappropriate.

19. Advertisements are not permitted on any exhibit, stall, pen or enclosure prior to judging.

20. During judging, ONLY STEWARDS are to be in attendance with the judges. The general public and exhibitors are not to interfere in the judging process in any manner.

GENERAL

21. Prize Money: Donated/sponsored cash prizes must be in the hands of the Treasurer before judging. All cash prizes will only be available from the Treasurer on Show Day. Prize Money to be claimed before the end of the Show year.

22. Stock suffering from any parasite or infectious disease must be removed immediately from the Showgrounds.

23. Vehicles not forming part of a vendor's display must be removed from the Showgrounds before 9am.

24. Exhibitors contravening the Rules and Regulations of the Society shall forfeit all Prize Money and Awards.

25. Ground space fees will be set by the Committee and spaces allocated by the Chief Ground Steward.

26. Badge-carrying GAS Members and Pass holders have free admission to the Show. All exhibitors are required to pay ground admission fees.

Exceptions: Horse floats & stock vehicles: Two persons per vehicle are permitted free access.

27. Any other matters arising in connection with or incidental to the Show shall be resolved by the Committee.

28. The Committee has the right to remove any persons from the Showgrounds without public explanation.

1 cup (170gm) seeded prunes, chopped coarsely
1 cup (150gm) dried currants
1/3 cup (80ml) dark rum
40gm butter, softened
1/2 cup (100gm) firmly packed brown sugar
2 eggs
1/2 cup (50gm) finely chopped pecans
40gm dark eating chocolate, finely grated
1/2 cup (75gm) plain flour
1/2 teaspoon bicarbonate of soda
200gm marzipan
2 tablespoons icing sugar
1/4 (60ml) dark rum, extra

Light Layer

90gm butter, softened
2/3 cup (150gm) caster sugar
2 eggs
1 cup (150gm) plain flour
1/3 cup (80ml) dark rum
3/4 cup (120gm) sultanas
1/2 cup (85gm) mixed peel
1/4 cup (55gm) finely chopped glace pineapple
1/2 cup (50gm) finely chopped pecans

METHOD

Dark Layer

1. Combine fruit and rum in medium bowl. Cover, stand overnight.
2. Line 20cm x 30cm lamington pan with baking paper, extending paper 3cm over long sides of pan.
3. Beat butter, sugar and eggs in small bowl with electric mixer until pale in colour (mixture will curdle, but will come together later). Add butter mixture to fruit mixture, stir in nuts, chocolate and sifted flour and soda. Spread mixture into pan.
4. Roll out marzipan on icing-sugared surface to 20cm x 30cm rectangle; place in pan over dark cake layer.
5. Preheat oven to 150C (130C fan forced).

LIGHT LAYER

1. To make light layer; beat butter, sugar and eggs in small bowl with electric mixer until pale in colour (mixture will curdle, but will come together later). Stir in sifted flour, rum, fruit and nuts. Spread mixtures evenly over marzipan.
2. Bake cake about 1 hour. Cover with foil; bake further 1 hour. Brush cake top with extra rum. Cover with foil; cool cake in pan.

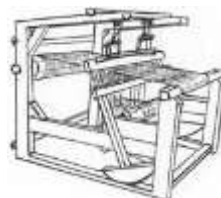

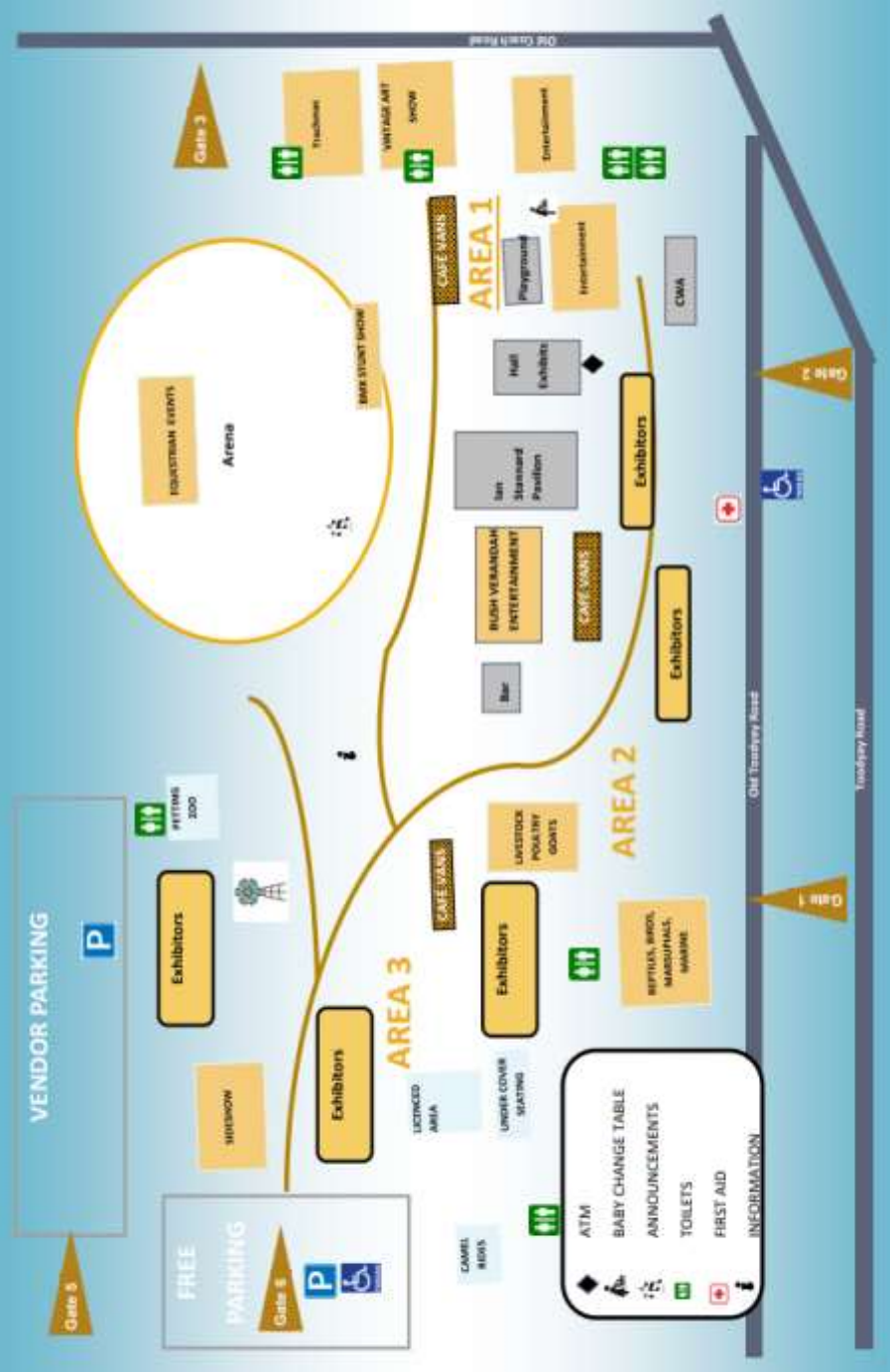
